Lake Research Partners designed and administered this pre-election and election night omnibus survey which was conducted by phone using professional interviewers November 6-8, 2016. The questions about voting and the demographics reached a total of 2,400 likely voters nationwide who voted in the 2016 elections – 1401 interviews among voters who were reached on cell phones and 999 interviews among voters who were reached a total of 1,200 likely voters nationwide who voted in the 2016 elections who were reached on landlines. Issue questions reached a total of 1,200 likely voters nationwide who voted in the 2016 elections (margin of error of \pm 2.8%). The data were weighted to reflect the aggregated Presidential vote as reported in the 2016 exit polls, as well as by gender, age, race, party identification, education, marital status, union household, and census region to reflect the actual proportions of the electorate. The survey has a margin of error of \pm 2.0% at the 95% confidence interval.

SURVEY METHODOLOGY

Lake Research Partners designed and administered this survey which was conducted using professional interviewers from November 6-8, 2016. The questions about voting and the demographics reached a total of 2,400 likely voters nationwide who voted in the 2016 elections – 1401 interviews among voters who were reached on cell phones and 999 interviews among voters who were reached on landlines. Issue questions reached a total of 1,200 likely voters nationwide who voted in the 2016 elections nationwide who voted in the 2016 elections (margin of error of +/-2.8%).

Telephone numbers were drawn from the Catalist voter file. The sample was stratified geographically based on the proportion of likely voters in each region. The data were weighted to reflect the aggregated Presidential vote as reported in the 2016 exit polls, as well as by gender, age, race, party identification, education, marital status, union household, and census region to reflect the actual proportions of the electorate.

The margin of error for total likely voter sample is +/-2.0%. In interpreting survey results, all sample surveys are subject to possible sampling error; that is, the results of a survey may differ from those which would be obtained if the entire population were interviewed. The size of the sampling error depends upon both the total number of respondents in the survey and the percentage distribution of responses to a particular question. For example, if 50% of respondents in a sample of 2,400 respondents answered "Yes" to a particular question, we can be 95% confident that the true percentage will fall within 2.0 points, or from 48.0% to 52.0%. The table below represents the estimated sampling error for different percentage distributions of responses.
