<sup>v</sup> This is no longer taught in ADTEP because many program dentists no longer perform this procedure. The CHAP Certification Board Standards and Procedures state that Alaska dental therapists should be able to recognize when space maintenance may be needed

<sup>vii</sup> No restriction to mobile teeth; can section tooth and extract fractured teeth, but cannot cut tissue or remove bone. Must be approved by dentist supervisor and be deemed an emergency per federal regulations in the Indian Healthcare Improvement Act/Affordable Care Act

viii Does not require authorization of the plan by supervising dentist

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>ii</sup> Not taught at this time, but there is nothing to prohibit a dentist to train a dental therapist in this procedure and allow it to be performed under general supervision
